WHEREAS the institution namely Vidyarthi Snatak Mahavidyalaya, Jagadishpur Bardiha, Post- Jagadishpur Dharmdani, Distt- Kushinagar, Uttar Pradesh, was granted recognition vide NRC, NCTE order No. F.NRC/NCTE/F-3/UP-1608/2005/7164-7173 dated 28.07.2005 for B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One Hundred only) students.

AND WHEREAS, as per court orders dated 25.07.2013 & 19.09.2013 ( D.B. order) passed in W.P.No. 20663/2008 & ors. and in Special Appeal defective Nos. 892,891, 893, 894/2013, the Northern Regional Committee in its Emergent meeting held on 07.05.2012, decided notice u/s 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution on the basis of the direction issued by the Hon'ble Court. Accordingly Show Cause Notice issued to the institution on 15.05.2014.

AND WHEREAS, the institution submitted its reply of the Show Cause Notice dated 15.05.2014 received in NRC office on 12.06.2014.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by the NRC in its 226<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 21.07.2014 and the Committee decided as under:-

- The recognition for B.Ed. course be withdrawn under Section 17 of the NCTE Act from the next academic session following the date of communication of this order on the ground that the institution had admitted students beyond the intake approved by NRC.

AND WHEREAS, the withdrawal order was issued to the institution on 08.08.2014.

AND WHEREAS, the institution filed an appeal in the NCTE Hq. against the NRC order dated 08.08.2014 and the appeal committee considered the matter and confirmed the NRC order vide order dated 25.11.2014.

AND WHEREAS, the institution submitted a representation along with court order dated 05.05.2017 received in NRC office on 12.05.2017.

AND WHEREAS, the court order was considered by the NRC in its 270<sup>th</sup> meeting held from 29<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> and the committee decided as under:-

- In compliance with the Order dated 05.05.2017 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Allahabad, NRC examined the case to decide the matter afresh as directed by the Hon'ble High Court.
- NRC decided that the recognition order issued to the institution before 08.08.2014 (the date on which the recognition was withdrawn by the NRC) be continued.
- It has been noted by the NRC that the institution was running the B.Ed. since it was granted recognition through an order dated 28.07.2005. NRC also noted that the institution was running the B.Ed. course since the session 2006-2007 with an intake of 100 students as sanctioned by the NRC.
- The Hon'ble High Court has also observed that the institution conducted the B.Ed. course from 2006-2007 to 2014-2015 without any other complaint.

Accordingly, NRC decided to continue the recognition order which was granted vide Order dated 28.07.2005.

NOW, THEREFORE, the recognition of the institution is hereby continued which was granted vide Order dated 28.7.2005 for B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two units) to "Vidyarthi Snatak Mahavidyalaya, Jagadishpur Bardiha, Post- Jagadishpur Dharmdani, Distt- Kushinagar, Uttar Pradesh,"

The institutions shall adhere to the fulfillment of the provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 and ensure the following before commencement of the session: -

- (i) The institution shall comply with various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.



- (ii) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- (iii) The institution shall comply with the condition as laid down in the clause 8(3) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 which provided that "An institution which has been recognized by the Council shall obtain accreditation from an accrediting agency approved by Council within five years of such recognition."
- (iv) The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
- (v) The Norms of staff/ qualifications/administrative and professional staff/terms and conditions of service etc. shall be as per the provisions of NCTE Regulations, 2014.

5. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc. as applicable and compliance of the following by the affiliating body, State Govt and also the concerned recognised Institution: -

- (i) The affiliating bodies/State Govt. shall be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building documents with the required land & built up area as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non-teaching staff as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 by the concerned institution before grant of affiliation to an institution.
- (ii) The affiliating body shall ensure that the institution is composite institution as per the definition of composite institution given in the NCTE Regulation, 2014. If at any stage, it is found that the institution as not a composite institution, the recognition, granted will be treated as withdrawn and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution. However, in the existing institutions permitted for additional intake, shall have to ensure that they are to become composite gradually preferably the academic session 2016-17.
- (iii) The staff approval thereof submitted by the institution, if found fake at any stage, the recognition, granted will be treated as withdrawn and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution.

6. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

7. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -

- (i) Copy of the Application Form
- (ii) Land and Building Particulars
- (iii) Staff Profile
- (iv) Recognition letter
- (v) Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

8. In case if the land is in the name of the Society/trust, the land is to be transferred within six months in the name of the institution, failing which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate about the same to the respective Regional Committee along with the new land documents within the stipulated time.

9. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

10. The Educational Institution shall follow Uniform Accounting System as brought out by ICAI and accepted by MHRD.

11. The Institution shall fill the GIS Application within one month of issue of this order.

12. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the order, it may prefer an appeal under sections 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 in the "online mode" available on NCTE's website [www.ncte-india.org](http://www.ncte-india.org) within 60 days from the date of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
